## AUDITOR'S REPORT: Sheri McNeal

M/S/C/U (Guthrie/Acoba) Motion carried to approve the auditor's report (copy attached) and payment of warrants, numbering 6784 through 6794, in the amount of \$1,447.00 as submitted.

Credit card charges for the period ending 1/10/22 totaled \$291.92 The Commissioners reviewed the statement and backup documentation. *The Google phone payments are now up to date.* 

Jeff Reynolds reviewed the financial statement ending December 2021. The Election charges from the County were noted.
